

**Football Parents Club Meeting**  
**September 29, 2010 – 7:00 p.m.**

- The meeting was called to order by Mark Dietel.

- A motion was made and seconded to approve the September 22, 2010 meeting minutes.
- A new treasurer's report was provided by Ron Daggett. All of the money is not in yet, but it appears that we will have made about \$7,500 from the pizza sales fundraiser. The senior class escrow account has been managed very well this year and is on track to meet its budget.

**Discussion Points:**

- Craft Fair – The craft fair on November 6<sup>th</sup> is quickly approaching. We will need volunteers to help set-up, tear-down, and work the fair. We will also need 5-6 volunteers to help put up signs around the community – the signs will be available on October 13<sup>th</sup>. Someone will also need to shadow Debbie Sutton this year so that we will have someone to run the craft fair fundraiser next year – this would be a great opportunity for an 8<sup>th</sup> grade or freshman parent.
- Cindy Battle organized the pizza sale this year and will need some to take over those responsibilities as she moves into a new role. Please let she or Ellen know if you can help.
- Spirit:
  - The CGMSC v. CGMSN Chili Supper is scheduled for Wednesday, October 13<sup>th</sup>. Michele Berryhill needs 8-10 volunteers to bring chili. We will also need volunteers to bring desserts and help with set-up and clean-up.
  - Senior Night is on October 15<sup>th</sup>. The O'Brien's will be making Italian beef for the spirit trailer. The freshmen and sophomore classes are responsible for set-up, serving, and clean-up on this night. Please let your class representative know if you can volunteer.

**Trainer Dave Buchholz** – Dave spoke to all of the parents about the causes, symptoms, treatment, statistics, and prevention methods associated with Sudden Cardiac Arrest (SCA). Handouts were provided to each of the parents in attendance. Dave advised that the school maintains three AED (defibrillators) to be used in such an event; one is not kept in the football locker room, but Dave brings one with him to the games. The parents discussed purchasing a defibrillator for the football locker room – they cost anywhere from \$750 to \$1,250. We

were also advised that Johnson County is currently running a program where you can have an echocardiogram completed on your son for a minimal fee (perhaps \$25); please note, this type of test may become mandatory for high school physicals in the near future.

**Coach Moore** – Discussed the Lawrence North last week and discussed the Ben Davis team that we will be facing this week. Ben Davis runs a similar defense and offense as Center Grove, and they understand it well. Their team is big and fast, so we will need to be in the game. Again, each of the games before sectionals will be very important, so it is equally important that the boys continue to push hard. Also, the end of the first 9 weeks is rapidly approaching and all of the boys need to make sure their grades are up so they will be able to participate in post-season play.
