

**Football Parents Club Meeting

- The meeting was called to order by Mark Dietel.
- A motion was made and seconded to approve the September 29, 2010 meeting minutes.
- A new treasurer's report was provided by Ron Daggett.

Discussion Points:

Jackie Renfrow, Chairperson for the Indy Chapter of Sudden Cardiac Arrest – Jackie spoke to all of the parents about the causes, symptoms, treatment, statistics, and prevention methods associated with Sudden Cardiac Arrest (SCA). Handouts were provided to each of the parents in attendance. Players can be tested by receiving an echocardiogram at any of the Community hospitals for \$25. The test can be administered to anyone over the age of 10 and should be completed on an annual basis.

Coach Moore –

- Coach Holmstead of CGMSC advised that his entire seventh grade team came through the first nine weeks without any academic problems!
