REPORTS/IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

- Motion was made and seconded to approve the March Parent Club meeting minutes.
- Ron Daggett gave the treasurer's report. After all receipts are paid, the pizza sales will have made about \$ 6,000. Great job everyone!
- Tony Sykes discussed sponsorships which will go directly to the Parents Club. Letters were circulated which delineated the different types of sponsorships. It was stressed that this money would go directly to the Parents Club.
- Mike Duke discussed sponsorships for the Gridiron Club. There are 4 different groups of potential contributors: family and friends, smaller businesses, big companies, and the television shows. There was a different letter circulated which described the criteria for these sponsorships.
