

Football Parents Club Meeting
April 20, 2010 – 7:00 p.m.
Center Grove High School Outdoor Locker Facility

- The meeting was called to order by treasurer, Ron Daggett.
- A motion was made and seconded to approve the March 10, 2010 meeting minutes.

Treasurer's Report:

- Pizza Sales were a success and will net \$6,000+ (\$3,000 went to expenses and \$875 went to incentives).
- Mike's Carwash – CG football will net 50% of the proceeds which will be used towards the CGFPC budget.
- Discussed profit and loss statement
 - Noted cash reserves, but no discussion as to how to use those reserves.

Discussion Points:

- Pizza Sale – Thank you to Cindy Battle and Kelly Rodriguez for all of their hard work.
- 7 on 7 Tournament – Cindy Adams advised that this event will be held on Saturday June 7, 2010. Thirty-two schools will be represented. Volunteers are needed for: referees, timers, concessions, and parking.
- Physicals – Ellen Huddleston advised that all players must have new physicals, dated after May 1, 2010, on file no later than the beginning of August (beginning of 2 x days). The physicals will be offered at CGMSN on May 4, 2010 between 5:30 pm – 7:00 pm and at CGHS on May 13 between 6:00 pm – 9:00 pm. All physicals at CGHS must be scheduled in advance through the Athletic Office. All of the money from these physicals benefits the training budget.
- Golf Outings – Cindy Adams spoke about two upcoming golf outings:
 - June 17, 2010 – the Athletic Booster Club is sponsoring a golf outing wherein the proceeds will benefit the camp costs for football. Although this outing is not sponsored by the football department, it is always well represented by football supporters.
 - July 9, 2010 – the Gridiron Club is sponsoring the first annual golf outing to be held at the Hickory Stick Golf Course. This golf outing is intended to give back to the alumni players and offer everyone an opportunity to catch up.
- Upcoming Dates to Remember:
 - Discount Card money must be turned in by April 30, 2010 or penalties will be assessed. All unsold cards must returned as soon as possible.
 - Coach Moore will be holding class meetings on the following dates: Freshman on May 14, 2010 (6:30 pm), Sophomores on May 18, 2010 (7:00 pm), Juniors on May 19, 2010 (7:00 pm), and Seniors on May 24, 2010 (7:00 pm).
 - Senior Car Wash will be held on July 10, 2010 in the parking lot of the Duke/Welbourne building on S.R. 135. Remember that this is a Senior fundraiser wherein all of the money will be used towards making their senior year special. Please participate in this fundraiser!
 - The repairs to the press box will not begin until sometime in July.

Coach Moore:

- Reminder that moratorium week will be June 27, 2010 – July 3, 2010 (this is a week earlier than usual). Practice will begin again on July 5, 2010. If you are traveling during this week, the coach will permit absenteeism provided those players communicate with him prior to that week so that the coaching staff may plan accordingly.
- Specifics on the two-a-day practice schedule are being finalized at this time and will be provided shortly.
- Thank you's were given to all of the parents that run the Sweet Shop and to those that helped orchestrate the pizza sales fundraiser.
- Coach Moore noted that there have been attendance problems at the character meetings. He encouraged all of the parents to email him and he would forward a copy of the attendance roster from those meetings so that they could verify that their son had been in attendance. The character program is a very good and relevant program that starts excellent conversations between the boys. Coach is planning to pass out a character manual for each of the boys to review and sign their agreement in order to create ownership of the behaviors contained within this program – we should expect to receive a copy of that manual at the next CGFPC meeting.
- Reminder that all incoming freshman are invited to attend the IU Camp this year, although it is not mandatory that they attend. The IU team camp forms were passed out to those in attendance. Everyone was reminded to NOT send in the form or write a check to IU – all camp fees will be payable to the Parent's Club and we will receive a discount due to the number of players attending. The camp will run Sunday through Tuesday and all players will be expected to ride the bus to and from the camp.
- Ball State will hold a Skills Camp at CGHS on Wednesday June 9, 2010 from 2:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m. Again, don't send your money to Ball State – all money will be made payable to the Parent's Club in order to ensure that all campers from CGHS receive the appropriate discount. This camp is expected to be staffed by several college coaches and should be a good experience for the players.
- CURRENT freshmen may stop by the locker room to pick up a travel bag if they haven't already.
- The practice schedule over the summer will provide the boys with Wednesdays off. Monday and Thursday practices will be weight training. Tuesday and Friday practices will be weight training and speed improvement.
- Scrimmages will be held on July 12, 2010 and July 19, 2010 again Hammond and Crown Point, respectively. Each of the scrimmages will take approximately 60 – 90 minutes with 25 plays of 7 on 7.
- Reminder that grades are very important as we head into the end of the school year – each of the players need to make sure to keep their grades up in order to play in the fall.
- Numbers are currently being assigned for the next season. The players can ask to have their numbers changed – family history (a brother with the same number, etc.) will take precedence, then sophomores have the next pick. Coach Moore discouraged Juniors and Seniors from changing their numbers so as not to cause confusion on highlight reels. For incoming freshmen, their numbers do not matter at this time.

- The fall roster is being determined at this time. The coaching staff is holding several key meetings to decide the lineup. Some positions changes may be necessary. Also, linemen are a key right now – there aren't enough linemen in the upcoming classes.
- A brief discussion was held on the progress of the track season. Player participation in the track team was encouraged due to the spirit of competition that is built in this sport. Coach Moore was very proud of the kids on the track team and their great attitude this season.
- Max out sheets were passed out to all of the parents, including both bench and power clean numbers. The player statistics are not sent to anyone outside of the organization other than Bigger, Faster, Stronger for a strength rating (which is not published anywhere); those ratings were passed out as well. Reminded that the power clean ratings are what colleges look for when assessing players.
- Beginning next week, colleges will begin recruiting again. Reminder that college coaches are not allowed to approach freshmen or sophomore players unless the kids bump into the recruiters and introduce themselves.
- Recruitment Update: Nick Stoner is being recruited by Indiana University and Joel Cox is being recruited by Florida and Ball State. The senior parents were invited to stay after the meeting for an in depth recruiting update.

Our next Parent Club meeting will be Wednesday, May 12, 2010 at 7:00 p.m.
