

FOOTBALL PARENTS' CLUB MEETING
July 15, 2009 – 7:00 P.M.
CENTER GROVE HIGH SCHOOL OUTDOOR LOCKER FACILITY

- The meeting was called to order by Mark Dietel, President.
- A motion was made and seconded to approve the June Parent Club minutes.
- Ron Daggett discussed the **Treasurer's Report**.
 - 7-on-7 profits are at approximately \$ 3,200.
- Tony Sykes gave a **sponsorship** update.
 - Check e-mail for sponsorship updates from class reps.
 - Currently at \$7,350, this puts us at almost the halfway mark to our goal of \$15,000. 2008 CG Senior football parents are pledging \$1,000 under the guidance of Brad Riley. 8% of our football families are involved – we'd love to see this percentage increase.
 - In order to get your name/ad in the fall program, Tony needs all information and monies by July 25th. The ads will then be submitted to Dave Whitehead by August 1st. Incentives are in the process of being ordered and include: stadium seats, shirts, signs. Mike Duke stated that signs are currently being designed.
- Kathy Shupe gave a special thank you to Kim Weeks who mended and Elizabeth Nevill who washed many of the jerseys in order to get them ready for the upcoming season.
- Kathy Shupe also discussed the upcoming **two-a-days** which run from August 3rd – 7th.
 - Volunteers are needed to make this week successful – a signup sheet was passed out and will also be sent via e-mail.
 - There are morning and afternoon meals with a Tuesday evening meal being served before the required DAT meeting which starts at 6:30 p.m.
 - Friday and Saturday's meals will be served in the Outdoor Locker Facility.
 - Saturday morning's breakfast (8/8) is served by CG Dads. Time will be posted.
 - Two-a-day donations can be brought to the CGHS café dock starting at 6 a.m Mon., Aug. 3rd and will be as follows:
 - Seniors and sophomores: 4 doz. Cookies or 2-3 pies
 - Juniors: 1 case (24) Gatorade or Powerade (20 oz. size)
 - Freshman: 3 boxes granola bars or breakfast bars or chz/pb crackers
- Elizabeth Nevill discussed the **Kick-off Pitch-In**. It is put on by the junior parents and is scheduled for Sunday, August 9 at the Duke's. A signup sheet was passed around and will also be sent via e-mail.
- Pam and Larry Calvert discussed the **Red/White Scrimmage** pitch-in scheduled for Saturday, August 8th. (JV vs. Freshman game will be Sat., 8/15)
 - All players need to bring one case of Dasani water to the Spirit Trailer. Indiana Members Credit Union will supply buns, hot dogs, and condiments for this event.
 - Donations will be as follows:
 - Seniors and sophomores: side dishes (BIG ones☺)
 - Juniors and freshman: desserts (also BIG ones☺)
- Pam Calvert discussed the season's tailgate meals held at the **Spirit Trailer** before each home game. Tents will be set up and the tailgate usually begins around 5:30 p.m.
 - One or a group of families sign up to bring the main course (e.g., BBQ, chili) which needs to be enough to feed a large group of people. This family or group of families is responsible for making, setting up and serving the main course.
 - All other families who attend bring a large side dish to share with all.
 - The first Spirit Trailer meal is scheduled for the Bloomington scrimmage on Friday, August 14th.

- Shelley Warrick discussed **yard signs/decals**. There are pole signs (sophs, jrs, and srs), yard signs, and window decals. Order forms were passed around and will also be sent via e-mail. Order forms and payment can be put in the locker room lockbox or sent to Shelley Warrick's address which will also be included in the e-mail.
- Volunteers were secured by Mark Dietel to provide water/Gatorade for all games.
- **Physicals** must be turned in to the high school athletic office by the end of July. No player can participate in two-a-days without a physical – NO exceptions. This is an IHSAA mandate. A list of incomplete/rejected physicals was circulated at the meeting.
- A weekly newsletter overseen by Lauren Cram will be coming soon.
- Kathy Shupe shared about **photo buttons**. Team and individual pictures will be taken on Tuesday of two-a-days (8/4). Your son will bring home a baggie with an order form. This is a fundraiser – the buttons are 2 for \$5 and will be ready at the Red/White scrimmage.
- **DAT** stands for Drugs, Alcohol, and Tobacco – this is a mandatory mtg in which all players and one parent must attend. A DAT form must be signed, dated by all freshmen.
- Cindy Adams discussed the progress and process of finding a bone marrow donor for Tyler Genneken. He will be an 8th grader at CGMS-Central and has an older brother who played football for Center Grove.
