

Football Parents Club Meeting
July 14, 2010 – 7:00 p.m.
Center Grove High School Outdoor Locker Facility

- The meeting was called to order by vice president, Ron Cram.
- A motion was made and seconded to approve the June 16, 2010 meeting minutes.

Treasurer's Report:

- Ron Daggett advised that he expects we exceeded our goal with regard to the 7 on 7 tournament and the Senior car wash netted approximately \$1,100.

Sponsorships:

- Pat O'Brien advised that we need to do significantly more to reach our sponsorship goal.
- Benjamin Franklin plumbing and Dial One Hour heating and air conditioning have offered to donate 5% of all service calls (with the flyer) to CGFPC.
- Pledge sheets were passed out. In order to make the fall program, sponsorships must be received by August 1, 2010. An e-mail to Pat O'Brien or Ron Daggett will suffice.

Gridiron:

- Mike Duke discussed the sponsorship and advertisement needs.
- The Friday Night Show will be held at Louie's Restaurant after the games; everyone is encouraged to attend that show taping.
- The Indy Outdoor Show is being planned – this will be a hunting show.
- Mike reminded everyone that additional help in obtaining sponsorships for the television program is needed.
- Thanks to the Adams' family for donating a van to the Gridiron club.
- Roughly 23 people attended the golf outing this year – it was so successful that they are already working on the golf outing for next year.

Discussion Points:

- Spirit Trailer
 - Pam Calvert advised that that every class will be asked to serve a spirit trailer meal. Senior parents will have the first home game; Junior parents will have the second home game; Sophomore parents will have the third home game and the Freshman parents will have the fourth and fifth home games.
 - Reminder that the Red and White scrimmage and football kickoff will be held on Saturday, Augustth. Qdoba will be donating the hotdogs, but all families will need to donate food as listed on the practice schedule.
 - All middle school and younger children need to be accompanied by a parent when near the spirit trailer.
 - The spirit trailer will be used for Coffee Cake Tailgate on Saturday mornings, 1 hour before the Freshmen games. Parents should donate coffee cake and donuts for this purpose.
- Two-a-Days
 - Elizabeth Nevill discussed the volunteer efforts for the two-a-day schedule. A sign-up sheet was passed around. Volunteers are needed to pick up the eggs and/or make Sam's Club runs.
 - Reminder that all players must shower prior to meals and wear sleeves to all meals.
 - Volunteers are also needed to bring Gatorade to home games and/or to take, set-up and clean-up after post-game away meals.

- All yard sign and decal forms must be turned in by July 31st for upperclassmen. All completed forms must be returned to Melissa. There will be a separate form for the Freshmen.
- The DAT (Drugs, Alcohol and Tobacco) meeting is mandatory for all athletes. The players must attend with at least one parent at the CGHS auditorium on August 12th at 6:30 pm.
- Mike's carwash money is due at the end of July – please place your money in the drop box as soon as possible.
- Reminder that there is no football on July 28th – 30th. Physicals MUST BE on file in order to return to practice after this break.

Coach Moore:

- Crown Point scrimmage will be held on July 19th at 5:00 pm.
- Coach Moore's NCAA clearinghouse worksheet was passed out. All Sophomores, Juniors, and Seniors must fill out these forms for coach to keep on file. Please fill out the grades and points before returning to coach. Having this information already on file will help in recruiting. Keep in mind that a B+, B, and B- are all calculated the same. Also, these worksheets should not be completed until after the grading scale is changed at the beginning of the school year.
- The CGFPC golf outing was a huge success and expect it to double next year.
- Thank you to Mr. Clark for his work on the state champs sign.
- Reminder that all football forms/money should be turned into the drop box by coach's office. However, physicals, DAT forms, etc. should be turned into the Athletic office (or front office).
- Freshmen are invited to the first week of two-a-days, but it is not mandatory. Each player must let the coaches know what they are doing so they know how many to expect and know where everyone is at.
- Moore would like to start a North/South all-stars and all-American section in the locker room where they will hang photos and jerseys – asked the Gridiron Club to help in the project.
- Moore would also like to start a wall honoring those in the military, such as Johnny Rankel.
- Reminder that players may wear Xenith helmets, but no one is trained on how to repair those helmets. If your player's helmet is broken in a game, they will likely have to sit out until their helmet can be repaired.
- Discussed DAT policy at length.
