

**Football Parents Club Meeting**  
**March 10, 2010**  
**Center Grove High School Outdoor Locker Facility**

- The meeting was called to order by vice president, Ron Cram.
- A motion was made and seconded to approve the February 10, 2010 meeting minutes.
- No Treasurer's Report was provided this month as Ron Daggett was not in attendance.

**Pizza Sale Fundraiser:**

- Ellen Huddleston discussed the upcoming pizza fundraiser scheduled for April 17, 2010.
- Volunteerism is critical to completing this fundraiser. Each football family will be expected to sign up to volunteer in at least two (2) of the major fundraisers this year.
- The participation gift this year will be a short sleeve moisture control shirt with the new Center Grove Football logo.

**Discount Card Fundraiser:**

- Discount cards will be distributed during the week of March 22, 2010. The upper classmen can pick up the discount cards from Coach Lyon at the high school. Coach Lyon will hold call-out meetings at both CGMSN and CGMSC for the incoming freshman to pick up their discount cards.
- Each football player needs to sell ten (10) discount cards for \$10.00 each.
- The money received from this fundraiser will go to cover the cost of equipment for each football player, such as shorts, shirt, practice jersey, etc.

**Sponsorships:**

- The Gridiron Club is organizing its First Annual Center Grove Football Golf Outing. The golf outing will most likely be held on Friday, July 9, 2010 at Hickory Stick Golf Course.
  - Family, friends and alumni of Center Grove football will be invited to attend this event.
  - This annual golf outing will be used to start an alumni club for the football team.
  - Daren Johnson will help spearhead the event.
- Mike Duke reported again that we already have a new T.V. sponsor for next year – *Roofing Made Easy*. Ten percent (10%) of each of their jobs will go directly to the football program. Ron Cram provided a testimonial for the services of *Roofing Made Easy*.
- The Gridiron Club will likely host an Outdoorsman Fishing Show with special guests.

**Coach Moore:**

- The IU team camp forms were passed out to those in attendance. Everyone was reminded to NOT send in the form or write a check to IU – all camp fees will be payable to the Parent's Club.
  - There was a reminder from Ron Cram that should anyone need help paying for the IU camp, that person should contact Ron Daggett or Mark Dietel.

- Incoming Freshman are invited to attend the IU Camp this year, although it is not mandatory that they attend. Coach Moore would prefer that the Incoming Freshman attend the Wing T Camp if they are only going to attend one camp and would prefer that they attend this camp over a non-Center Grove camp.
- Nike is putting together optional sweat suits for the football players to purchase for \$80.00.
  - The players will receive their sweat suits at no charge if they sell five (5) of the items that Nike makes available for sale. More information will be provided closer to the beginning of the season.

- Reminder that the Student Council Conference will be during the prior week of June 21, 2010 – June 25, 2010. The workout schedule will be altered due to the facility availability that week.
- Coach Moore was disappointed at the attendance of the character meetings as of late. He will be discussing this matter with the players on Friday of this week.
  - The Incoming Freshman will be introduced to the character program this summer.
- Recruitment Update: Scotty O'Brien signed with Washington University in St. Louis earlier this week.

**Cost-cutting for School Corporation:**

- Cindy Adams gave an update from the Booster's Club meeting on February 10, 2010.
  - They are looking for private donations to cover the cost of the referendum vote scheduled for July 13, 2010.
  - Encouraged everyone over 18, including prior Center Grove football players, to come out and vote.
  - Also looking for volunteers to go from door to door to solicit votes for the referendum.
- Currently, the football team is slated to lose an assistant coach and a freshman coach, as well as, pay cuts for each of the coaches.
